

# PUBLIC NOTICE

## DEPARTMENT FOR TRANSPORT

### TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990

The Secretary of State gives notice of the proposal to make an Order under section 247 of the above Act to authorise the stopping up of various highways on land bounded by Hunter Street, Northgate Street, Watergate Street and St Martin's Way at Chester, in the District of Cheshire West and Chester.

If made, the Order would authorise the stopping up only to enable development to be carried out should planning permission be granted by Cheshire West and Chester Council. The Secretary of State gives notice of the draft Order under Section 253 (1) of the 1990 Act.

Copies of the draft Order and relevant plan will be available for inspection during normal opening hours at The Forum Office, Chester CH1 2HS in the 28 days commencing on 20 July 2017, and may be obtained, free of charge, from the address stated below quoting NATTRAN/NW/S247/2938.
