

Council to provide, in some convenient Situations in the Borough, or continue as now provided, such requisite Houses and Buildings for Firemen, and for the Reception and Custody of Fire Engines, Water Carts, and other Apparatus, and Stabling for Horses, as the Council shall think necessary, and from Time to Time to alter the Situations of the present and all future Fire Engine Stations.

Council to provide Fire Engines, Firemen, &c.

CLXXXIII. And be it enacted, That it shall be lawful for the Council and they are hereby required to purchase or provide such Engines for extinguishing Fire, and such Water Buckets, Pipes, and other Apparatus for such Engines, and such Water Carts for supplying the same with Water, and such Fire Escapes and other Implements for Safety or Use in case of Fire, and to purchase, keep, or hire such Horses for drawing such Engines and Water Carts, as they shall think fit, and to employ a proper Number of Persons to act as Superintendents and Firemen for directing and working the said Engines, and as Drivers for the said Engines and Water Carts, and to allow them such Salaries as they may think proper, with full Power and Authority to displace and remove such Superintendents, Firemen, and other Servants from Time to Time, and appoint others in their Stead, and also with full Power and Authority to regulate the Expenditure of the said Establishment, and from Time to Time to frame such Regulations for preventing Neglect or Abuse, and for rendering such Superintendents, Firemen, and other Persons employed in the said Fire Police efficient in the Discharge of their Duties, as the Council shall think fit, and generally to do all other Matters and Things which they may deem expedient, with a view to the good Government and Utility of the said Fire Police.

Fire Police going out of the Borough.

CLXXXIV. And be it enacted, That it shall be lawful for the Chairman of the Watch Committee of the Borough, or the Superintendent of the Police, to permit such Engines, Implements, and Apparatus, and any Part of the Fire Police Establishment, to proceed beyond the Limits of the Borough for the extinguishing of Fire happening to Property in the Neighbourhood thereof; and the Owners of such Property shall in such Case defray the actual Expence that may be thereby incurred, and shall also pay to the Treasurer in aid of the Lamp Rate a reasonable Charge for the Use of such Engines, Implements, and Apparatus, and for the Attendance of such Fire Police; and in case of Difference between the Watch Committee and the Owners of the said Property the Amount of the said Expences and Charges, as well as the Propriety of the said Engines, Implements and Apparatus and Fire Police so proceeding as aforesaid for the extinguishing of such Fire (if the Propriety thereof be disputed), shall be summarily determined by any Justice, whose Decision shall be final and conclusive on all Parties; and the Amount of the said Expences and Charge, in case of Dispute, may be fixed by the Justice, and shall be recovered in like Manner as any Penalties under this Act may be recovered.

Power to enlarge present Market Halls and

CLXXXV. And be it enacted, That it shall be lawful for the Council when and as they shall think fit to enlarge the present Market Halls and Market Places in the Borough, or any of them,  
and

and to erect and build such other and more spacious and convenient Market Halls and Places within the Borough, for buying and selling of Meat, Fish, Poultry, Eggs, Butter, Corn, Vegetables, and all and every the several other marketable Commodities now usually sold or exposed for Sale in the present Market Halls and Market Places within the Borough, as the Council shall from Time to Time think expedient, and to provide and furnish such Market Halls and Market Places with such suitable and convenient Stands and Stalls therein as the Council shall deem requisite or necessary, and also to make and maintain such suitable and spacious Avenues and Approaches thereto as the Council shall think proper.

CLXXXVI. And be it enacted, That when any new Market Halls or Market Places shall have been provided as aforesaid, it shall be lawful for the Council either to discontinue the Use of the present Market Halls and Places as such, and to use and convert the same to or for any other Purpose whatsoever, or to continue the same as such Market Halls and Places as aforesaid, notwithstanding the Erection and building of such other Market Halls and Places as aforesaid.

CLXXXVII. And be it enacted, That it shall be lawful for the Council, when and as they shall think fit, to establish and provide proper and convenient Places in the Borough for holding Markets and Fairs for buying and selling of Cattle and other Live Stock, with commodious Avenues and Approaches thereto, and to erect such Pens, Stalls, and other Conveniences for the Accommodation of Persons frequenting such Markets or Fairs as the Council shall deem necessary or expedient.

CLXXXVIII. And be it enacted, That, until proper and convenient Places shall be provided and established for the buying and selling of Cattle and Live Stock, the Markets and Fairs for buying and selling the same shall be held in such Places as the Council shall from Time to Time direct and appoint.

CLXXXIX. And be it enacted, That it shall be lawful for the Council, at any Time and from Time to Time, when and as they shall think proper, to make and provide such convenient Place or Places within the Borough for holding Markets for the Sale of Coals, Lime, Hay, Straw, and for holding Markets or Fairs for the Sale of Cheese, and of all other Articles and Commodities whatsoever not herein-before provided for, with suitable and proper Approaches and Conveniences thereto, for the Accommodation of Persons frequenting the same, as the Council shall think proper.

CXC. And in order the more effectually to provide sufficient and eligible Sites for the several Market Halls and Market Places for the buying and selling of Meat, Fish, Poultry, Eggs, Butter, Corn, Vegetables, and other marketable Commodities, and Markets for the buying and selling of Cattle and Live Stock, Coals, Lime, Hay, and Straw, and Places for holding Markets or Fairs for the Sale of Cheese and other Commodities, be it enacted, That it shall be lawful for the Council from Time to Time to set apart and appropriate any
