New market fit-out underway

Members of the Northgate Joint Member Working Group visited the market to see the first stalls being constructed.

Constructed from 60 tonnes of air dried English oak, and machined locally in Cheshire Oaks no less, the market's 40 stalls will provide an impressive backdrop for our fantastic line-up of traders. There will be four seating areas with a total of 400 seats, across the central atrium, garden and mini-market areas, plus additional al fresco seating along the new Princess St. walkway. Cycle Hub

The New Market Parking will include a 50-space cycle hub – the city centre's first dedicated indoor cycle park.

Work is underway to fit-out the secure cycle hub which will include a repair station and e-bike charging facilities. Thanks to the Chester Cycle Campaign for their support in designing the space. A further 50 outdoor cycle spaces will be incorporated into Northgate, including within the central Exchange Square.
